A tapestry of significant buildings in the village of Long Compton made for the church alterations in 2004

INFORMATION IS SITUATED ON THE Hexagonal display cabinet made from local timber in 2004 in memory of a past Churchwarden, Mr Ray Slatter, and his wife Ruth.

The Chancel carpet designed and made in 1959-60 by village ladies of 'The Birds of the Air and The Flowers of the Field', and including the Key of St Peter and the Ship of St Paul.

In 2004 the west end was altered to provide a meeting room, toilet and kitchen facilities downstairs ~ quiet room for prayer and balcony upstairs
